Students are therefore, requested to nominate candidates for the ministerial posts as outlined below:

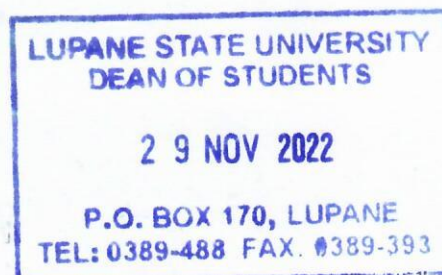
1. Nomination of Candidates for the SEC Posts

Students' Executive Council (SEC) Elections for the 2022/2023 Academic year will be conducted online. Only **registered** undergraduate conventional students will be eligible to participate in the elections. Nomination of candidates for the posts of the Students' Executive Council will open on **Tuesday, 29 November 2022 at 1000 hours** and close on **Friday, 2 December 2022 at 1600 hours**.

To make nominations, students should follow the provided link on their portals.

3. Criteria for Standing for SEC Elections

A nomination must be endorsed by not less than ten (10) students entitled to vote. A student, even if registered, shall not be allowed to stand for elections if:

- i. He/she has carried one or more modules in the preceding semester(s).
- ii. He/she is a fourth year second semester student OR fifth year second semester student depending on the degree programme.
- iii. He/she is going for work-related learning in the succeeding semester.
- iv. He/she is on work-related learning.
- v. The student was found guilty of gross negligence or misconduct by the University Disciplinary Committee in his/her previous semesters.
- vi. The student has not completed at least one full semester at LSU.

4. Date of SEC Elections

SEC Ministerial elections shall be held on **Thursday, 8 December 2022.**

NB: Students are encouraged to register and participate in the elections.
